2301 SCOPE

This part applies to the specified roads in the Whangamata Community. The purpose is to restrict Heavy Vehicle movements within the urban area of Whangamata.

2302 INTERPRETATION

In this part “Roading Manager” means the Roading Manager for the time being, his deputy or assistant or any other such person specially or generally authorised by the Council to perform the duties of the Roading Manager.

“Vehicle” or “Heavy Motor Vehicle” or “Gross Weight” shall have the meanings ascribed to them by the Heavy Motor Vehicle Regulations 1974.

“Road” means the road described in Schedule A.

2303 PROHIBITION OF CERTAIN CLASSES OF TRAFFIC

No person shall drive on roads described in Schedule A or operate or cause or permit to be driven or operated along or over the road any vehicle or combination of vehicles the gross weight of which exceeds 8,000kgs, with the exception of buses.

2304 DISPENSATION

Notwithstanding anything contained in this Part, if, on written application to her/him, the Roading Manager considers it necessary to dispense with the provisions of this Part in full or in part, the Roading Manager may grant a permit for such dispensation for specified journeys during a specified period of time. Any dispensation granted under this clause shall be subject to such conditions as may be specified by the Roading Manager.

2305 OFFENCES

- (a) Any person who fails to comply with the provisions of this Bylaw or fails to comply with the terms and conditions in any dispensation or permit given or issued hereunder shall be guilty of an offence under this Bylaw.
- (b) Any person who causes, permits or allows any person acting as his agent or employee to commit an offence against this Bylaw shall himself be guilty of an offence against this Bylaw.

2306 EFFECTIVE DATE

This bylaw will come into effect on 8 September 2004.

SCHEDULE A – PROHIBITED ROADS

All that part of the road in the Whangamata Community commencing at the junction of State Highway 25 and Harry Watt Drive and continuing along Harry Watt Drive to its junction with the causeway and bridge across the Moana-anu-anu River and thence along the said causeway and bridge to the junction with the north-western end of Hetherington Road and then along Hetherington Road to the intersection of Martyn Road.
