

6.4 Members' Reports

At the discretion of the Community Board, Reihana Robinson, resident of Port Charles joined the meeting to make a presentation on matters contained within the Coromandel and Outlying Communities Plan that in her opinion did not accurately reflect the desires of the community.

Member Ward declared a conflict of interest and took no part in the discussion or resolution.

Pest Proof Fence in Colville - Eight submissions were received in opposition to the pest proof fence and one late submission was received in support.

Use of 1080 in the Ward - No reference to the communities request for 'No 1080' in the Community Plan, or the Coromandel-Colville Community Board's resolution to request that only traps, hunting and cyanide be used in the Ward for pest control.

In addition Ms Robinson queried the sections for both Manaia and Harataunga (Kennedy Bay). it was noted that Manaia have a stand-alone community plan for their community and Harataunga made no further submission during the review period.

Resolved

That the Coromandel-Colville Community Board:

1. Receives the information
2. Reiterates its opposition to the use of 1080 in the Coromandel-Colville Ward and its support for alternative methods of pest eradication eg; hunting, trapping and cyanide.
3. Request an addendum to the current 2010-2020 Coromandel and Outlying Communities Plan be appended to reflect the submissions received regarding the Pest Proof Fence and the use of 1080 within the Ward.
