1. Introduction

1.1. Pursuant to Section 684(1)(13) of the Local Government Act 1974, the Local Government Act 2002 and Land Transport Rule: Setting of Speed Limits 2003 the Thames-Coromandel District Council makes this bylaw to set speed limits as specified on the maps listed in the Schedule.

2. Title

2.1. The title of this bylaw is the Speed Limit Bylaw 2005.

3. Date the Speed Limits Come Into Force

3.1. The speed limits described in the schedules come into force on the date specified in the schedules.

4. Interpretation

5. Speed Limits

5.1. The roads or areas as described in the schedules specified below or shown on a map referenced in the schedules are declared to have the speed limits specified on the schedules and maps, which are part of this bylaw.

6. Schedules

6.1. Council may by resolution publicly notified, amend any schedule or map to this Bylaw.

Urban Traffic Areas are defined by 50km/h speed limits on the plans.

Schedule 1: Roads that have a speed limit of 20 km/h.

Schedule 2: Roads that have a speed limit of 30 km/hr.

Schedule 3: Roads that have a speed limit of 40 km/hr.

Schedule 4: Urban traffic areas – roads that have a speed limit of 50 km/hr.

Schedule 5: Roads that have a speed limit of 60 km/hr.

Schedule 6: Roads that have a speed limit of 70 km/hr.

Schedule 7: Roads that have a speed limit of 80 km/hr.

Schedule 8: Rural areas – roads that have a speed limit of 100 km/hr.

Schedule 9: Roads that have a holiday speed limit.

Schedule 10: Roads that have a variable speed limit.

Schedule 11: Roads that have a minimum speed limit.
